3.2 <u>Underground Services – Beach Avenue</u>

Staff:

- Telus advised the City last year that they could no longer participate in the City's Electrical Undergrounding Program (sharing of costs of putting ducts underground as part of upgrading of existing neighbourhoods) and still be competitive.
- The City's utility right-of-way along Beach Avenue is already dug up for other utility installations and staff are looking at options and strategies for also getting the telephone lines underground before covering in the boulevard.

Council:

- In order to complete the Beach Avenue job, the City may have to pay for the ducting for now and then try to collect from Telus later.
