(BYLAWS PRESENTED FOR FIRST THREE READINGS)

- 7.1 Bylaw No. 8643 – Sanitary Sewer Specified Area No. 29 – Totom/Campion Roads
Initiates a specified area for extending sewer to properties on Totom, Lloyd, Campion & Cambro Roads.
- 7.2 Bylaw No. 8644 – Amendment No. 10 to Development Application Fees Bylaw No. 8034
Adds a \$500 fees for processing liquor licensing applications requiring a Council resolution to expand licensed capacity and a \$50 fee for liquor license applications that do not require a Council resolution.
- 7.3 Bylaw No. 8645 – Sanitary Sewer Specified Area No. 29 Parcel Tax Bylaw
Authorization for Council to impose a parcel tax on all benefiting parcels in the Totom/Campion Specified Sewer Area.
