In April of 1998, the Ben Lee Park Committee was formed with the assistance of Partners in Parks, and this committee later became the properly registered *Friends of Ben Lee Park Society*. In October of 1998, a sub-committee of the Society was created for the expressed purpose to raise money, awareness and community interest for the development of a skateboard park facility. This <u>Ben Lee Skatepark Committee</u> has now been very active for over two years and their activities and history include:

- Recommendation to the Parks and Leisure Services Department on August 14, 1997 requesting Skate-park be built,
- Friends of Ben Lee Park Committee was established on April 15, 1998,
- A Ben Lee Skatepark Committee was formed on October 22, 1998,
- The majority of the members come from direct involvement and experience with the sport of skateboarding,
- Some committee members had assisted in building and designing of other parks in BC, including the ones in Whistler and Vancouver,
- Many committee members have skated in many skateparks throughout North America and have considerable knowledge and experience as to the best design features, especially from the technical expertise perspective,
- Most committee members have been involved in the design, construction and fund raising aspects for this skateboard park facility,
- <u>The Ben Lee Skatepark Committee</u> has;
 - organized open forums,
 - conducted a contest with local skateboard outlets which attracted over 100 submissions,
 - conducted skateboarding demonstrations, e.g. Green Bay Bible College competition,
 - visited other skateparks to see which components of a skatepark would best suit riders of varying experience and skill levels, (Vernon, Whistler, Lake Country, Vancouver, Burnaby),
 - conducted some fund raising initiatives, (hot dog sales, 50/50 draw),
 - constructed a 8' x 8' model of the skateboard park to promote and generate interest,
 - gained support and involvement from local skateboard shops,
 - reviewed many concepts and designs,
 - explored the internet and visited over 20 sites that specialize in skatepark design and components to gain even more knowledge about successful skatepark design components,
- Following ~ 20 months of obtaining this current knowledge, the <u>Ben Lee Skatepark</u> <u>Committee</u> invited two of the best firms they could identify, to submit design proposals,
- On November 22, 2000 the committee recommended to the Society to negotiate with the firm of van der Zalm and Associates Inc./New Line Skatepark Inc,
- On December 11, 2000 the <u>Ben Lee Skatepark Committee</u> reviewed and revised the proposal for design and building of the new facility with City staff and van der Zalm and Associates Inc./New Line Skatepark Inc.
- the <u>Ben Lee Skatepark Committee</u> believe that 2 1/2 years spent on research has given us the knowledge to proceed van der Zalm and Associates Inc./New Line Skatepark Inc
