RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council approve the Downtown Kelowna Association 2001 budget;

AND THAT Council approve a grant to the Downtown Kelowna Association for 2001 in the amount of \$362,000, to be funded by a levy on Class 5 and 6 properties located within the boundaries of the improvement area.

BACKGROUND:

Council approved the Kelowna Downtown Business Improvement Area Bylaw No. 8273 on October 26, 1998. This bylaw established the specified area for the purposes of annually funding activities of the Downtown Kelowna Association over a five-year period (to 2003). Council is empowered to grant the Association an amount included in their annual budget and not exceeding the sum of \$400,000 per annum.

The 2001 DKA budget (schedule 1) has been consolidated to include all funding sources and expenditures. A statement of revenues and expenditures for 2000 (schedule 2) is also included for Council information. Audited financial statements will be forwarded to the City after their completion. While staff have not participated in or assisted the DKA in preparation of their annual budget, a good working relationship continues to be maintained with the Board Chair and Executive Director.

Representatives of the Downtown Kelowna Association will be present to answer any questions Council may have regarding their 2000 or 2001 programs.
