CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 8672

A bylaw to authorize the expenditure of monies in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for 2001

WHEREAS, there is an unappropriated balance in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund of Two Million, Two Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$2,284,668.00) as at January 1st, 2001 which amount has been calculated as follows:

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for the purpose of land purchases and enhancements set out below;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sum of Two Million, Two Hundred Eighty-Four Thousand, Six Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$2,284,668.00) is hereby appropriated from the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund to be expended in 2001 for the following purposes:

Environmental Investigation - City-Owned Land	\$ 85,000.00
Parks and General Land Acquisition	<u>\$2,199,668.00</u>

- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of Council.
- 3. Should any of the above remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the City-Owned Land Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2001, No. 8672".
