Subject: 2001 Local Improvement Program

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT preparation of construction bylaws on the project listed in the Transportation Manager's report dated July 3, 2001 be approved;

AND THAT Council receive the attached 635 Report for the 2001 project.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Kelowna has started upgrading of water, sewer and road infrastructure on Marshall Street from Rowcliff to Buckland. As part of this work, residents have petitioned for local improvements to allow for landscaping, curb, gutter and asphalt widening. As well, the City will be installing heritage style lighting fixtures, heritage conservation area street signage and benches. Council is requested to approve the local improvement bylaw to allow for the work to proceed. The residents have petitioned for a second local improvement for underground conduits, wiring and works for street lighting to remove existing utility poles.
