REPORT:

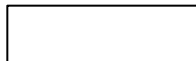
Due to the resignation of the former chair of the Community Housing Needs Committee, there has been a vacancy since last December. At its June meeting, the Committee recommended Michelle Rule as the additional member to fill the vacancy.

Advertising for the applications to fill this vacancy on the City's web page yielded little response. Ms. Rule's name was suggested by Committee members, and she was contacted by staff to see if she would be interested. Ms. Rule ran for the position of City Councillor during the last municipal election and has an interest in affordable and accessible housing issues. According to the terms of reference, her membership will fill in the remainder of Glenn Bowden's term, running parallel with that of Council. Greg Dusik was appointed as Chair following Glenn Bowden's resignation. Mr. Bowden had to step down from the Committee due to out-of-town commitments.
