RECOMMENDATION:

THAT City Council re-appoint Yvonne Topf and Bob Huff to the City of Kelowna Art Foundation for a three year period commencing January 1, 2002;

AND THAT City Council appoint the four new members, Earla Henderson, John Mutter, Angela de Burger, and Anette Lemieux to the City of Kelowna Art Foundation for a three-year period commencing April 1, 2002;

AND THAT City Council receive the information on the Executive Committee officials and the remaining Board members for the City of Kelowna Art Foundation.

DISCUSSION:

The constitution and by-laws of the City of Kelowna Art Foundation requires City Council to appoint the Board members to the Foundation. At a recent meeting of the Foundation on January 23, 2002, the Foundation followed the regular procedure to interview and select new members. Attached is a letter from the Foundation providing some biographical information on each of the four new members.

The constitution and by-laws also provides for Board members to be able to serve two consecution terms. During the annual general meeting of the Foundation on December 16, 2001, the Foundation also followed the regular procedure to re-appoint Yvonne Topf and Bob Huff to a second three year term.

Alice Hargreaves and David Mapleton have completed their term with the Foundation and are stepping down effective December 31, 2001.
