Subject: **Award of Construction Contract:
Magic Estates Drainage Upgrade**

Recommendation:

THAT the tender for the Magic Estates Drainage Upgrade be awarded to the low bidder, R & L Excavating, in the amount of Seven Hundred & Twenty Two Thousand, Six Hundred & Three dollars and twenty cents (\$722,603.20) including GST and Contingency;

AND FURTHER THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the City of Kelowna.

Background

As part of the on-going upgrade to the City of Kelowna drainage system, Tender TE02-03 was issued for the construction of approximately 1100 metres of pipe, a storm water pumping station and associated works.

6 bids were received. They are as follows (including GST and contingency):

R & L Excavating	\$ 722,603
Ansell Construction	\$ 854,537
Danric Construction	\$ 885,627
Intercoast Construction	\$ 888,282
Matcon Construction	\$ 898,051
Lawrence Enterprises	\$1,071,576

The City of Kelowna and the consultants have reviewed the bid submissions and are recommending the acceptance of the low bidder, R & L Excavating.

Funding for this project is included in the 2002 Financial Plan.

The project is anticipated to start approximately June 10th and be complete by July 31st.
