## **BYLAW NO. 8885**

### **Road Exchange Bylaw Westpoint Drive**

**A bylaw pursuant to Section 525 of the Local Government Act to authorize the City to dispose of a portion of highway, being a portion of Westpoint Drive in exchange for a portion of Lot A, Plan 18576,**

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. The City of Kelowna is hereby authorized to convey to the registered owners of Lot A, District Lot 358 Osoyoos Division Yale District Plan 18576, those portions of highway shown as Closed Road Parcel A comprising 0.39 square metres and Closed Road Parcel B comprising 316 square metres, both shown in bold black on the attached reduced Reference Plan prepared by Douglas A. Goddard, B.C.L.S., and completed on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July 2002, for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration and in exchange for those portions of land described in Paragraph 3.
2. The said Closed Road A and Closed Road B described in Paragraph 1 are hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
3. The lands described in Paragraph 1 are conveyed from the Crown Provincial in exchange for the transfer from the registered owners of those portions of Lot A, District Lot 358 Osoyoos Division Yale District Plan 18576 shown as Road Parcel C comprising an area of 25 square metres, Road Parcel D comprising an area of 6 square metres, and Road Parcel E comprising an area of 324 square metres all shown in bold black on Reference Plan referred to in Paragraph 1.
4. The said Road Parcel C, Road Parcel D and Road Parcel E described in Paragraph 3 shall be established as portions of highway.
5. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.

6. Before adoption of this bylaw, notice of intention shall be given by advertisement pursuant to Section 525 of the Local Government Act.
