## **BYLAW NO. 8995**

## Road Exchange Bylaw Palmer Road

A bylaw pursuant to Section 525 of the Local Government Act to authorize the City to dispose of a portion of highway, being a portion of Palmer road in exchange for a portion of Lot 8, Block 8, Sections 28, 29 & 32, Township 26, Osoyoos Division Yale District, Plan 896 in the City of Kelowna, British Columbia

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- The City of Kelowna is hereby authorized to convey to the registered owners of Lot 8, Block 8, Sections 28, 29 & 32, Township 26, Osoyoos Division Yale District, Plan 896, that portion of highway shown as Parcel A in bold black and cross hatched adjacent to Lot 8, Block 8, Plan 896 comprising 0.423 Ha. on Reference Plan prepared by Bruce H. Davies, B.C.L.S., and completed on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April 2003, for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration and in exchange for that portion or tract of land described in Paragraph 3.
- 2. The said Closed Road described in Paragraph 1 is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The lands described in Paragraph 1 are conveyed from the Crown Provincial in exchange for the transfer from the registered owners of that portion of Lot 8, Block 8, Sections 28, 29 & 32, Township 26, Sections Plan 896 comprising 0.4 square metres shown as Parcel B in bold black on the Reference Plan referred to in Paragraph 1.
- 4. The said road described in Paragraph 3 shall be established as a portion of highway.
- 5. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.

6. Before adoption of this bylaw, notice of intention shall be given by advertisement pursuant to Section 525 of the Local Government Act.
