CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 9026

Road Exchange Bylaw Union Road

A bylaw pursuant to Section 525 of the Local Government Act to authorize the City to dispose of a portion of Union Road in exchange for a portion of Lot A, Plan KAP69724 in the City of Kelowna, British Columbia

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The City of Kelowna is hereby authorized to convey to the registered owners of Lot A, Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 Township 23 ODYD Plan KAP69724 except Plan KAP71944 that portion of highway shown cross hatched in Bold Black as Parcel 2 lying adjacent to Lot A, Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 Township 23 ODYD Plan KAP69724 except Plan KAP71944 comprising 0.194 Ha and that portion of highway shown cross hatched in Bold Black as Parcel 3 lying adjacent to Lot A, Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 Township 23 ODYD Plan KAP69724 except Plan KAP71944 comprising 233 square metres on Reference Plan prepared by T.E. Ferguson, B.C.L.S., and completed on the 28th day of April 2003, attached to this bylaw for the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other valuable consideration and in exchange for that portion or tract of land described in Paragraph 3.
- 2. The said closed road described in Paragraph 1 is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic.
- 3. The lands described in Paragraph 1 are conveyed from the Crown Provincial in exchange for the transfer from the registered owners of that portion of Lot A, Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 Township 23 ODYD Plan KAP69724 except Plan KAP71944 comprising an area of .218 Ha shown as Parcel 1 in Bold Black on the Reference Plan referred to in Paragraph 1.
- 4. The said road described in Paragraph 3 shall be established as a portion of highway.
- 5. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.
- 6. Before adoption of this bylaw, notice of intention shall be given by advertisement pursuant to Section 525 of the Local Government Act.
