BYLAW NO. 9061

Amendment No. 6 to “City of Kelowna Parks Bylaw No. 6819-91”

A bylaw to amend the “City of Kelowna Parks Bylaw No. 6819-91” in order to permit dogs in certain parks for certain special events

The Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT City of Kelowna Parks Bylaw No. 6819 –91 be amended by adding the following:
sub-section to Part 3 – PROHIBITIONS:

3.32 Notwithstanding the provisions of **sub-sections 3.8, 3.9, 3.26 and 3.27** of this Bylaw, a person may be permitted to bring a dog to a special event, run or walk in a park that is not designated either a "Dog Walking Park" or a "Dog Off-leash Park", in the following circumstances:
 - (a) where the special event is an annual event which has been occurring since a date prior to July 2003, and at which dogs have historically been permitted as a specific attraction, dogs shall continue to be permitted at the event, run or walk in a park if approved under the conditions of the Outdoor Events Bylaw No. 8358;
 - (b) where the special event, run or walk is not an annual event which has been occurring since a date prior to July 2003, or is not one at which dogs have historically been permitted, dogs may be permitted at the event, run or walk in a park, other than a waterfront or beach park, if approved under the conditions of the Outdoor Events Bylaw No. 8358.
2. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect and is binding on all persons as and from the date of adoption.
