Counter Petition Opportunity

RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council receive the Certificate of Sufficiency dated August 28th, 2003 pertaining to the sub-lease of land at the Kelowna International Airport to Shell Canada Products Ltd. for the continued operation of a bulk storage facility for a further term of 10 years.

BACKGROUND:

At its July 21st, 2003 regular meeting Council resolved to enter into a new sub-lease with Shell Canada Products Ltd. for an aviation fuel and lubricating bulk storage facility at the Kelowna International Airport, for a term of 10 years. Council set a deadline for receipt of Counter Petitions against the sub-lease for the term of 10 years of 4:00 p.m. August 27th, 2003.

Notice of the Counter Petition Opportunity in relation to the sub-lease was advertised in the Kelowna Daily Courier on July 23rd and 24th, 2003. As of the deadline the City Clerk received no Counter Petitions.
