CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 9117

A bylaw to amend City of Kelowna Nuisance Trees and Shrubs Bylaw No. 6469-89.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT City of Kelowna Nuisance Trees and Shrubs Bylaw No. 6469-89 be amended by:
 - (a) Deleting the definition of "Nuisance" from section 1 of the bylaw and replacing it with the following:

"Nuisance" shall mean any part of a tree, shrub, hedge or bush that:

- extends over a highway at a height lower than 5 metres;
- (i) extends ove(ii) is a hazard;
- (iii) adversely affects the safety or convenience of the public; or
- (iv) is injurious to any highway road bed, sidewalk, utility or other public work.
- (a) Adding the following definition in the appropriate location in section 1 of the bylaw:
 - "<u>Hazard</u>" shall mean any standing dead tree that is closer than its height to a property line, or or any tree that is closer than its height to a property line and has been assessed by a certified arborist to be a hazard. For certainty, any standing burned tree with no apparent live growth shall be considered a standing dead tree.
- 2. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect and be binding on all persons as from the date of adoption.
