# Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw 415 Glenmore Road

A bylaw pursuant to Section 40 of the Community Charter to authorize the City to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of a portion of highway on Glenmore Road

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That portion of highway attached as Schedule "A" comprising 0.281 m², shown in bold black as Parcel A, on the Reference Plan prepared by Thomas E. Furguson, B.C.L.S., and completed on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2004, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the highway deadication removed.
- 2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.

#### PUBLIC NOTICE
