PAGE: 1 of 1 APPROVAL DATE: **RESOLUTION #:** REPLACING #: N/A DATE OF LAST REVIEW: March 2004 SUBJECT: CONFLICT OF INTEREST In accordance with the Community Charter, it is the personal responsibility of each member of Council to be aware in good faith of his or her conflicts of interest and to make the decision to declare them and to conduct him or herself in accordance with that legislation. If a question as to a possible conflict of interest of a member of Council is raised to the City Manager by someone other than that particular member of Council, the City Manager shall notify the member in writing as soon as possible, not including the name of the person raising the question. The City Manager and the member in guestion shall determine whether it is in the City's best interest to seek legal advice as to the possible conflict of interest from the City's legal service provider. In any event, the member in question may at any time obtain his or her own legal advice as to the possible conflict of interest from his or her own legal advisor.

- If legal advice is sought by the City Manager from the City's legal service provider as to a possible 5. conflict of interest, the cost of such advice shall be paid for by the City.
- If legal advice is sought by a member of Council from his or her own legal advisor as to a possible 6. conflict of interest, the cost of such advice shall be paid for by the member.
- If legal advice is sought by the City Manager from the City's legal service provider as to a possible 7. conflict of interest, the solicitor-client privilege pertaining to that advice is the City's.
- If legal advice is sought by a member of Council from his or her own legal advisor as to a possible 8. conflict of interest, the solicitor-client privilege pertaining to that advice is the member's.
