Subject: Award of Contract TE04-08 – 2004 Traffic Signal Program

RECOMMENDATION :

THAT the Contract for installing two (2) new traffic signals, installation of communication conduit and cable and upgrading traffic signals at seven (7) intersections be awarded to Trans-Western Electric Ltd. for the amount of \$388,167.11 which includes contingency and GST;

AND THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the City.

BACKGROUND:

This Contract includes the installation of:

- Installation of two (2) new traffic signals (Hollywood Road / Houghton Road and Enterprise Way / Banks Road)
- Installation of communication conduit and cable (Enterprise Way / Cooper Road to Banks Road)
- Installation of overhead yellow flashing lights (Chute Lake Road /Chute Lake Crescent)
- Upgrading of existing traffic signal equipment (such as larger traffic signal heads with LED signals and replacing vehicle detection)

In response to the City's invitation to Tender TE04-08, three bids were received, as shown below in order of amount including contingency and GST:

Trans-Western Electric Ltd.	\$388,167.11
Raylec Power Ltd.	\$436,645.60
C.G.L. Contracting Ltd.	\$485,887.00

Our Consultant has reviewed the bid submissions for accuracy and a recommendation. Trans-Western Electric Ltd. complies with the tender specifications, drawings, bid bond, and labour and material bonds. The Contractor's price is less than the City and Consultant estimates. The Capital budget for this contract comes from three separate Transportation Division accounts and partial funding from ICBC's Road Improvement program.

The construction work for this Contract is anticipated to commence in early July and be completed by the end of October 2004.
