RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council receive the Certificate of Sufficiency dated August 24th, 2004 pertaining to a Joint Use Agreement with School District #23 for Watson Road Community School for the purpose of incorporating additional space in the school facility and provide for community use and recreation programming in several areas of the facility and playfields. The term of the proposed Joint Use Agreement is for five (5) years with the option to renew this Agreement for three (3) consecutive five (5) year terms.

BACKGROUND:

At its June 28th, 2004 regular meeting Council resolved to enter into a Joint Use Agreement with School District #23 for Watson Road Community School for the purpose of incorporating additional space in the school facility and provide for community use and recreation programming in several areas of the facility and playfields. Council set a deadline for receipt of elector responses against the Agreement of 4:00 p.m. August 23rd, 2004.

Notice of the Alternate Approval Process in relation to the Agreement was advertised in the Kelowna Daily Courier on July 15th and July 22nd, 2004. As of the deadline the City Clerk received 0 elector responses.
