BYLAW NO. 9312

Amendment No. 11 to Fire Prevention Regulations Bylaw No. 6110-88

The Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That "Fire Prevention Regulations Bylaw No. 6110-88" be amended by:
 - (a) Adding to Sub-paragraph (b) in **Section 6.1 GENERAL of PART VI – REGULATIONS** after the sentence that ends “ at least two (2) years or to the satisfaction of the Chief.” the following:

“The Chief may issue a special permit to allow burning of woody debris for the purpose of fuel reduction or hazard abatement on private or public property.”;
 - (b) Amending Sub-paragraph (i) to **Section 6.1 - GENERAL of PART VI – REGULATIONS** by changing the dates from “October 15th to April 15th” to “September 1st to April 30th”.
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect as and from the date of adoption.
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Bylaw No. 9312, being Amendment No. 11 to Fire Prevention Regulations Bylaw No. 6110-88".
