**RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Council rescind Bylaw No. 6206-88 – City of Kelowna Gas Bylaw in its entirety and all amendments there to;

AND THAT Council consider City of Kelowna Gas Bylaw No. 9316 for first three readings.

**Background:**

Since the inception of the Safety Authority Act, the Provincial Government has adopted other pieces of enabling legislation. One of those pieces of legislation is the Safety Standards Act, (The Act), Section 5(3) of which allows for an Administrative Agreement with a local government to administer provisions of this Act and the Regulations. That Agreement has been entered into between the Province and the City of Kelowna. In order to administer the Act and Regulations the attached bylaw is required.

The new Gas Bylaw also includes a new fee schedule. This schedule reflects the charges set by the Province and results in a minor fee increase for Kelowna, the first in eight years.
