CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 9331

Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw (Part of Haynes Road and Underhill Street)

A bylaw pursuant to Section 40 of the Community Charter to authorize the City to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of a portion of highway on part of Haynes Road and part of Underhill Street.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That portion of highway attached as Schedule "A" comprising; that part of Haynes Road shown in bold black as Closed Road Parcel B; and that part of Underhill Street shown in bold black as Closed Road Parcel A, on the Reference Plan prepared by Douglas A. Goddard, B.C.L.S. and completed on 15th day of May, 2003, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the highway dedication removed.
- 2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.
- 3. "Road Exchange Bylaw, Haynes Road and Underhill Road, No. 9037", and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed.
- 4. This bylaw shall come into force and effect and is binding on all persons upon the date of adoption.
