**Subject:** Amendment to Sign Bylaw No. 8235 – Size of Election Signs

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Council receive the Report of the Acting City Clerk dated March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2005;

AND THAT Bylaw 9391 be advanced for readings consideration.

## **BACKGROUND:**

During the Regular Council Meeting of March 14<sup>th</sup>, 2005 Council debated the merits of amending certain sections of the City of Kelowna Sign Bylaw No. 8235 dealing with election signs. Council instructed staff to come back with an amendment to increase the maximum size of an election sign from 1.0m<sup>2</sup> to 1.50m<sup>2</sup> [approximately 4 feet by 4 feet].

Staff is reviewing the current provisions of Sign Bylaw No. 8235 based on Council's discussion from March 14<sup>th</sup> and will be bringing forward further amendments for Council's consideration. This amendment is being brought forward now in order that candidates running in the upcoming Provincial election may place their sign orders in accordance with the City's bylaw.
