## BYLAW NO. 9452

### **Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw** **(2530 Enterprise Way)**

**A bylaw pursuant to Section 40 of the Community Charter to authorize the City to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of a portion of highway on Lot 1, Plan KAP69740 (2530 Enterprise Way)**

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That portion of highway attached as Schedule "A" comprising 92.8 m<sup>2</sup> shown in bold black as CLOSED ROAD on the Reference Plan prepared by Douglas A. Goddard, B.C.L.S. and completed on 24th day of June, 2005, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the highway dedication removed.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.



