BYLAW NO. 9453

Amendment No. 9 to “City of Kelowna Parks and Public Spaces Bylaw No. 6819-91”

A bylaw to amend the “City of Kelowna Parks and Public Spaces Bylaw No. 6819-91” in order to regulate certain nuisances on public spaces.

The Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That City of Kelowna Parks and Public Spaces Bylaw No. 6819 –91 be amended by:
 - (a) deleting subsection 3.20 in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

“3.20 No person shall obstruct, interfere with, impede, hinder or prevent a bylaw enforcement officer, lifeguard, officer, employee of the City or other person engaged by the City from performing any duties or exercising any authority under this bylaw.”
 - (b) adding new subsections after subsection 3.35 as follows:
 - “3.36 No person shall urinate or defecate in or on any park or any public space except in a provided public or private toilet facility.
 - 3.37 No person shall be permitted in any park or public space to possess paraphernalia used for the purposes of storing, transporting or using illegal drugs.
 - 3.38 Any person who violates any provision of this bylaw or who suffers or permits any act or thing to be done in contravention or in violation of any of the provisions of this bylaw or who neglects or refrains from doing anything required to be done by any of the provisions of this bylaw, or who does any act which constitutes an offence against the bylaw may be ordered to leave from any park or public space.”
2. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect and is binding on all persons as and from the date of adoption.

Read a first, second and third time by the Municipal Council this 11th day of July, 2005.
