BYLAW NO. 9482

Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw **(Palmer Road)**

A bylaw pursuant to Section 40 of the Community Charter to authorize the City to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of a portion of highway on Palmer Road

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That portion of highway attached as Schedule "A" comprising 0.423 hectares shown in bold black as Palmer Road Parcel A on the Reference Plan prepared by Bruce H. Davies, B.C.L.S. and completed on 30th day of August, 2005, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the highway dedication removed.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.
3. City of Kelowna Road Exchange Palmer Road Bylaw No. 8995 with all amendments to it is hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "City of Kelowna Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication, Palmer Road Bylaw No. 9482".
