BYLAW NO. 9519

HD05-0001 – City of Kelowna

Heritage Designation J.D. Pettigrew House – 732 Dehart Avenue

WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna considers the building known as the “J.D. Pettigrew House” located at 732 Dehart Avenue, Kelowna, B.C. to be a building with heritage value and that the designation of the building as a heritage site pursuant to Section 967 of the *Local Government Act* is desirable for the conservation of the building;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The building and land known as the ‘J.D. Pettigrew House’ situated on lands legally described as Lot 2, District Lot 138, ODYD, Plan 490 located on Dehart Avenue, Kelowna B.C. to be commonly known in the future as the “J.D. Pettigrew House” is hereby designated a Municipal Heritage Site pursuant to Section 967 of the *Local Government Act*.
2. Except as authorized by this bylaw or as authorized by a Heritage Alteration Permit approved by Council, no person shall:
 - (a) alter the exterior of any building situated on the property designated by this bylaw;
 - (b) make a structural change to a building or structure situated on property designated by this bylaw;
 - (c) move any building situated on the property designated by this bylaw;
 - (d) alter, remove or take an action that would damage a landscape feature on the property designated by this bylaw; or
 - (e) alter, excavate or build on land designated by this bylaw.
3. The following alterations to the designated property are hereby authorized without a Heritage Alteration Permit:
 - (a) Normal day to day maintenance and repairs.
4. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the 'Heritage Designation Bylaw No. 9519 (J. D. Pettigrew House)'.
