BYLAW NO. 9523

Amendment No. 12 to Fire Prevention Regulations Bylaw No. 6110-88

The Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. That "Fire Prevention Regulations Bylaw No. 6110-88" be amended by:
 - (a) Deleting the sentences in Sub-paragraph (b) in **Section 6.1 GENERAL of PART VI – REGULATIONS** that read:

“Despite the issuance of a special burning permit, no burning shall take place unless the venting index as provided daily by the Federal Mountain Services Weather Office is fifty-four (54) or greater when the fire is started. In addition fires are prohibit during fair or poor air quality condiditons, when the air quality index is above twenty-five (25), as defined by the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection based on information provided by Envrionment Canada and the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection.”

and replacing it with;

“Despite the issuance of a special burning permit, no burning shall take place unless the venting index as provided daily by the Federal Mountain Services Weather Office is fifty-five (55) or greater when the fire is started. In addition fires are prohibit during fair or poor air quality conditions, when the air quality index is below twenty-five (25), as defined by the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection based on information provided by Environment Canada and the Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection.”;
 - (b) Adding a new Sub-paragraph (n) in its appropriate location to **Section 6.1 - GENERAL of PART VI – REGULATIONS** the following:

“(n) Notwithstanding paragraph 6.1 (b) of this bylaw, the Chief may issue a special burning permit for the purpose of burning wood waste removed from any property damaged by the Mountain Pine Beetle or Western Pine Beetle infestation. Damaged material maybe be burned on property other then that of its place of origin. Such a permit shall specify the conditions and restrictions the Chief determines are necessary, and shall specify the location at which the waste is to be burned.”
2. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect as and from the date of adoption.
3. This bylaw may be cited as "Bylaw No. 9523 being Amendment No. 12 to Fire Prevention Regulations Bylaw No. 6110-88".
