## **BYLAW NO. 9540**

## Amendment No. 4 to Local Service Area (Sewer Specified Area) No. 20 Bylaw No. 8929 (North Rutland)

WHEREAS under the provisions of the *Local Government Act*, the Council of the City of Kelowna adopted Bylaw No. 8929 establishing Local Service Area (Sewer Specified Area) No. 20;

AND WHEREAS section 19 of the *Community Charter Transitional Provisions, Consequential Amendments and Other Amendments Act* deems such specified areas to be local service areas under Division 5 of Part 7 of the *Community Charter*,

AND WHEREAS section 218 of the *Community Charter* provides that Council may, by bylaw, reduce or enlarge the size of a local service area;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Kelowna has received a petition from the owners of certain properties to have the municipality undertake the construction of a sewer system within the Local Service Area (Specified Specified Area) created by this bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the Corporate Officer of the City of Kelowna has determined the sufficiency of the petition under the provision of Section 212 of the *Community Charter*;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. THAT the servicing boundary of Local Service Area (Sewer Specified Area) No. 20, established by Bylaw No. 8929, be amended by adding:

Lot A, Section 35 and 36, Township 26, ODYD, Plan KAP52361;

2. AND FURTHER THAT the servicing boundary of Local Service Area (Sewer Specified Area) No. 20, established by Bylaw No. 8929, be amended by deleting:

Lot 5, District Lot 143, ODYD, Plan KAP45330;

- 3. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect and is binding on all persons as and from the date of adoption.
- 4. This bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "Bylaw No. 9540, being Amendment No. 4 to Local Service Area (Sewer Specified Area) No. 20 Bylaw No. 8929 (North Rutland)".
