RECOMMENDATION:

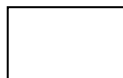
THAT Council approve awarding the tender for the hauling of compost materials to Sun-Oka Valley Transport Ltd.

DISCUSSION:

On February 9, 2006, bids were received in response to Tender T06-016 for the hauling of compost materials from Tolko Industries, Gorman Bros. Sawmill and the Glenmore Landfill to the compost facilities located on Beaver Lake Road and Commonage Road for the period of three years with the option to extend for two additional one year periods. The following bids were received, taxes extra:
