# CITY OF KELOWNA BYLAW NO. 9609

# A Bylaw to Establish Fees and Charges for Recreation, Parks and Cultural Services

WHEREAS pursuant to the *Community Charter*, City Council may, by bylaw, impose a fee payable in respect of all or part of a service of the municipality, the use of municipal property, or the exercise of authority to regulate, prohibit or impose requirements;

AND WHEREAS Council is desirous of setting fees and charges for the use of, or admission to, certain recreation, parks and cultural services and facilities;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. Pursuant to Section 194 of the *Community Charter*, there are hereby levied the fees or charges for recreation, parks and cultural services and facilities as set out in Schedules "A" to "H" attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 2. In addition to any fee or charge set out in Schedules "A" to "H", the following shall apply:
  - (a) A damage deposit may be required for rental of a City of Kelowna facility, with the minimum amount being \$300.00 and the maximum amount to be determined by the Director of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Services or his or her designate, based upon the facility in question and the risks for damage posed by the proposed event;
  - (b) A \$20.00 service charge shall be applied to all payments returned NSF;
  - (c) Overdue accounts shall be subject to a 1.5% per month interest charge (18% per annum);
  - (d) Where a monthly instalment payment plan is made available to users for the purchase of annual passes, a \$30.00 service charge shall be applied for set-up of the plan;
  - (e) Where overnight parking at a City of Kelowna facility has been approved pursuant to the City's Outdoor Events Bylaw No. 8358 for participants of tournaments or special events, a fee of \$15.00 per vehicle per night shall be charged;
- 3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the City of Kelowna " Recreation, Parks and Cultural Services Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 9609".

- Rental Deposit: A non-refundable (will be retained if the booking is cancelled) rental deposit is due and payable at the time of booking to secure the rental. The amount is dependent upon the rental agreement total amount payable and shall be as follows:

#### Ticketed Events in Waterfront Park & City Park – Gross Gate

Rental rates for ticketed events will be based on a percentage of gross ticket sales or base park rental, whichever is greater. The rate is based on the event dates only (Set up and takedown days will not be included in the calculation).


- If City Park/Waterfront Park is open to ticket holders only, the formula applied is **# of tickets** sold x ticket price x applicable gross gate % to a maximum of \$8,000.00.
- If the closure only affects Waterfront Park Island Stage (leaving the Boardwalk open to the public), the formula applied is *# of tickets sold x ticket price x applicable gross gate % to a maximum of \$5,000.00*.
- If the event is on multiple days, the above applicable formula applies to the highest gross revenue day with the remaining day(s) maximum ceiling calculated at 50%.

Groups must operate ticket sales through a recognized local ticket agency or make alternate arrangements to the satisfaction of the City of Kelowna.

If the fee for admission to the event is via donation, and the donation amount is at the discretion of the entrant, then only the base rent will be applied.

**Ticket Policy and Deposit**: Licensees using Ticketmaster or Select Your Tickets will be charged a deposit of 25% of the gross estimated rental fee. Licensees selling their own tickets or using a different ticket seller will be required to pay a deposit of \$2000 to confirm the reservation of the Kelowna Community theatre for the period covered in the applicable rental contract. Deposits are non-refundable.

**Technician Fees**: 8 hours of technician time is included with performance day rentals at the Kelowna Community Theatre and 4 hours are included on non performance days. Pre-scheduled additional hours will be charged at a rate of \$32 per hour. Unscheduled additional hours will be charged at a rate of \$48 per hour for the first two hours and \$64 per hour for all additional hours in accordance with union policy.
