NEW BUSINESS

(a) <u>Meeting with School Board</u>

Mayor Shepherd polled Council for who will be attending the meeting with the School Board on Friday, November 10th from 10 a.m. to noon at the School Board office.

(b) <u>Travel Authorization - 100,000 Solar Roofs Task Team</u>

Moved by Councillor Hobson/Seconded by Councillor Rule

<u>R994/06/11/06</u> THAT Mayor Shepherd be authorized to travel to participate on the 100,000 Solar Roofs Task Team, a provincial initiative which over the course of a year will develop a strategy to accelerate uptake of solar technology in B.C., with expenses paid in accordance with Council Remuneration and Expense Bylaw No. 7547, using funds from Account No. 351-10-011-0-001.

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(c) <u>Travel Expenses for Visit to Veendam in Spring 2007</u>

(e) <u>FortisBC – Site for Utility Sub-Station</u>

People at Quail Ridge are concerned that FortisBC may be planning to locate a major substation on Pier Mac industrial land near the entrance to their community. City Manager to investigate.
