Changes to Blue Bag Recycling Program

- All #1-7 rigid plastic containers and plastic film:
 - Yoghurt and margarine containers
 - Shampoo, bleach and soap bottles
 - Buckets
 - Grocery bags
 - Shrink wrap
- Expect to collect 2,000 tonnes in 2007



Changes to Blue Bag Recycling Program

Glass will be collected only at depo

Four recycling depots

- Glenmore Landfill
- 144 Cambro Road
- 1988 Kirschner
- Westside Landfill
- Four bottle depots
 - Lake Country Return It Centre
 - 680 Dease Road
 - 1988 Kirschner
 - Boucherie Bottle Depot
- Presently collect 250 tonnes per year
- Expect to collect 150 tonnes per year



Why More Plastics?

 Surveys show strong support for increased plastics recycling

- RDCO (2003)
- City of Kelowna (2005)
- Solid Waste Management Plan (2006)
- 100s of letters, emails, phone calls
- Neighbouring RDs and Cities collect and recycle plastics
- Market for mixed plastics better



Why Glass at Depots?

Tiny glass shards embed into paper fibre

 Many paper mills won't buy paper from single-stream recycling programs

Wears the equipment

De-values paper

Paper sale value is lower



Why Glass at Depots?

Two-stream collection is more expensive

30% more expensive

Would require new collection contract

RDOS \$1.19/hhld/collection


Depot collection will save processing fees

\$15,000/year



Costs

- Increased cost
 - Approximately \$1.55 per household per year
