RECOMMENDATION:

THAT Council receive the Certificate of Sufficiency dated February 27, 2007 pertaining to Kelowna Art Gallery Lease & Operating Agreement;

AND THAT Council direct the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the lease and operating agreement.

BACKGROUND:

On January 15, 2007 Council approved the Kelowna Art Gallery Lease and Operating Agreement as attached to the report from the Development Manager, Recreation Parks and Cultural Services dated December 27, 2006.

Council set a deadline for receipt of elector responses (the "Alternative Approval Process") against the proceeding of the Kelowna Art Gallery Lease and Operating Agreement, of 4:00 p.m., Monday, February 26, 2007 at its January 15, 2007 regular meeting.

Notice of the Alternative Approval Process was advertised in the Kelowna Daily Courier on January 19, 2007 and January 23, 2007 and in the Capital News on January 19, 2007 and January 24, 2007. As of the deadline the City Clerk had received zero (0) valid elector responses. This is less than the 8,436 responses required to prevent the lease and operating agreement from proceeding.

It is now in order for the Kelowna Art Gallery Lease and Operating Agreement to be executed.
