1.0 <u>RECOMMENDATION</u>

THAT in accordance with Development Application Procedures Bylaw No. 8140 the deadline for the adoption of Zone Amending Bylaw No. 9354 (Z04-0048) – 218555 BC Ltd. Et al – Stremel Road be extended from February 22, 2007 to August 22, 2007.

2.0 SUMMARY

The above noted development application was originally considered at a Public Hearing by Council on February 22, 2005. This application was extended to lapse on February 22, 2007.

Section 2.10.1 of Procedure Bylaw No. 8140 states that:

Every amendment bylaw which has not been finally adopted by Council within 12 months after the date it was given third reading, lapses and will be of no force and effect, and an applicant who wishes to proceed with its application must initiate a new application.

Z04-0048 – Page 2.

Section 2.10.2 of the Procedure Bylaw makes provision for Council to consider an extension to an amending bylaw for up to 6 months beyond the 12 months deadline as stated in Section 2.10.1.

The applicant has made application for rezoning (Z04-0048) to permit the development of an Industrial Subdivision on the subject properties. By-Law No. 9354 received second and third readings on February 22, 2005, after the Public Hearing held on the same date. This application was extended to lapse on February 22, 2007. The applicant wishes to have this application remain open for an additional six months in order to provide more time to resolve a number of outstanding issues.

This project remains unchanged and is the same in all respects as originally applied for.

The Planning and Development Services Department recommends Council consider the request for an extension favourably.
