BYLAW NO. 9792

Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2007

WHEREAS, there is an unappropriated balance in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund of Four Million, Six Hundred Sixty Thousand, Six Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$4,660,679.00) as at January 1st, 2007.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for the purpose of land purchases and enhancements set out below;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sum of Four Million, Six Hundred Sixty Thousand, Six Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$4,660,679.00) is hereby appropriated from the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund to be expended in 2007 for the following purposes:

General Land Acquisition Parks Housing Opportunity \$ 143,070.00 \$3,609,874.00 \$ 907,735.00

\$4,660,679.00

- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of Council.
- Should any of the above remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the City-Owned Land Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2007, No. 9792".
