RE: Snowbirds fly for CH.I.L.D in Kelowna 2007

As to follow-up from our discussion yesterday, Chairman HON Grace MaCarthy meeting with the Mayor and the welcome support letter received from Mayor Sheperd, I wish to formally ask the City of Kelowna for some integral support items required for the Snowbird's air demonstration performance on August 15th, 2007 over Kelowna's waterfront at Okanagan Lake.

As expressed this show is unique. It is one of only two shows that the Snowbirds perform for charity. In the west the Snowbirds are Ambassadors for the CH.I.L.D Foundation.

The free event is for the residents and tourists of Kelowna to enjoy and to assist the CHIL D Foundation's quest to capture and revitalize a new audience that will appreciate the Foundation's mission to raise funds for medical research into Crohn's Disease, ulcerative colitis, and liver disorders in children with a goal to find a cure for these disorders.

We are excited to be flying in Kelowna again, however there are some minor operational requirements we need for the event;

- Tables (x2) at show centre
- Tent (12x12) and stage at show centre
- Power & cable at show centre for AV – as the entire show is orchestrated to music.
- Substantial porta-potties in the park area
- Parking for Snowbird narrators cars
- Parking for Snowbird AV set-up vendor motor home .
- Police/Fire/water /EHS related infrastructure required for the mandatory secure show box and related emergency / safety support system. This is well underway – and compliments thus far with a great team.

Our sound engineer, Peter Young, will be in Kelowna on the Monday the 13th, to speck out the area and to plan the power tap in required for the satellite remote speakers and show centre control board.
