Graffiti Eradication and Prevention Program

- -From January 2007 until July 2007, the Graffiti Hotline received 436 calls for service of which 314 were related to City owned property.
- -There are 123 participants in the Adopt-A-Spot Program in which each participant is responsible for keeping one location free of graffiti for a minimum of 6 months. Individuals seeking to participate can pick a location or have one assigned by the coordinator. Supplies are provided.
- -June saw the launch of "The Big Picture Project". On June 11th, under the direction of artist Scott Tobin, students from the CHOICES program along with classmates of Springvalley Middle School began painting this large scale mural. The mural is located on the back wall of 355 Spedding Court in order to bring art to an unexpected location, offer an opportunity for artistic expression by youth, enhance the area, and serve as an invitation to additional projects that celebrate Kelowna's rich and diverse cultural community.
