BYLAW NO. 9572

Amendment No. 4 to Clean Indoor Air and Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 5980-86

The Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Clean Indoor Air and Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 5980-86 be amended by adding the following subsection to Section 2 <u>PROHIBITION</u>:
 - "(c) No person shall carry or have in his possession a burning cigarette, cigar, or pipe containing burning tobacco, or burn tobacco in any other manner within 10 metres of any entrance or exit to the Kelowna International Airport main terminal building."
- 2. AND THAT Clean Indoor Air and Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 5980-86 be amended by deleting Sections 6 and 7 in their entirety and replacing them with the following:
 - "6. OFFENCE AND PENALTY

Any person who contravenes a provision of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and, on summary conviction, shall be liable to a fine of not less than \$25.00 and not more than \$500.00 for the first offence; not less than \$75.00 and not more than \$500.00 for the second offence; and not less than \$150.00 and not more than \$500.00 for the third and subsequent offences."

3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Bylaw No. 9572, being Amendment No. 4 to Clean Indoor Air and Smoking Regulation Bylaw No. 5980-86."
