Re: Kelowna Municipal RCMP Detachment Policing Activity Report - August 2007

Please note below the policing report reflecting key activities undertaken by the Kelowna RCMP for the month of August, 2007. I will highlight the key statistical data for the most common criminal activities, and provide a short narrative overview of criminal trends and resources.

City Drug Section Highlights

The resources of the City Drug Section were significantly reduced during the summer months. The remaining resources of this Section did, however initiate some large scale drug investigations during this time period of which they are continuing to focus on.

Downtown Enforcement Unit (DEU) - Highlights

Members of DEU conducted 2 drug search warrants near the Red Zone of Kelowna. Bike Squad assisted with policing the downtown area while DEU conducted the warrant files and conducted a higher presence in the City Parks. All parks have been heavily monitored during this time with more attention given to City Park and Gyro Beach as more complaints were being generated for belligerent drunk people. The downtown city core appears to have fewer prolific offenders currently hanging around causing problems, which has been noted by downtown business owners as well as the Public.

Property Crime - Highlights

Members of the Property Crime Section assisted General Duty members with an investigation involving the recovery of stolen property and the arrest of a well known suspect involved in property crime.

Kelowna's Property Crime Section is actively investigating several rooftop-style break and enters that have occurred over the past several months.

Community Operations Support Unit COSU - Highlights

The Graffiti Coordinator Colleen Cornock spear-headed several clean-ups throughout the City of Kelowna during the month of August. The clean-ups involved the participation of various community based groups including Church groups, students, as well as neighborhood associations.

The "Big Picture project", a mural painted on the grounds of Spring Valley Middle School in support of the Graffiti Eradication Program, was completed. There will be an official dedication scheduled for the beginning of October.

Community Policing Coordinator Garth Letcher participated in a meeting with representatives of the City Parks Department, including the Parks Manager. This initial meeting focused on issues raised by the Parks Department in relation to flagrant drug and alcohol use in various Parks throughout the City of Kelowna (ie. Gyro Beach). The participants agreed to work with each other in a coordinated effort to address these issues in the coming months.
