BYLAW NO. 9843

Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw (Portions of Truswell Road and Martin Road)

A bylaw pursuant to Section 40 of the Community Charter to authorize the City to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of a portion of highway on Truswell Road and Martin Road.

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That portion of highway attached as Schedule "A" comprising 1520 m² shown in bold black as Closed Road on the Reference Plan prepared by Runnalls Denby Land Surveyors and completed on 12th day of September, 2007, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the highway dedication removed.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.
3. This Bylaw shall be cited for all purposes as "City of Kelowna Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication, Portions of Truswell Road and Martin Road, Road Bylaw No. 9843".

Read a first, second and third time by the Municipal Council this 1st day of October, 2007.
