BYLAW NO. 9904

AMENDMENT NO. 4 to SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT REGULATION BYLAW No. 9570

The Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- THAT Section 4 of SCHEDULE "E" SANITARY LANDFILL/RECYCLING FEES of "Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw No. 9570" be amended by deleting reference to the fee of \$60.83 to cover sanitary landfill refuse disposal costs, recycling programs and waste reduction activities, and replacing it with the fee of \$61.38.
- 2. AND THAT **Subsection 1.2 INTERPRETATION** of **Section 1- INTRODUCTION** of "Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw No. 9570" be amended by:
 - (a) deleting sub-section (b) of the definition *Mandatory Recyclable Material* and replacing it with the following:
 - "(b) "Mandatory Landfill or Recycling Depot Recyclable Material", being all Mandatory Residential Recyclable Material, plus lead-acid batteries, White Goods, tires, asphalt, concrete, Recyclable Gypsum, and includes all products listed in the Provincial Environmental Management Act's Recycling Regulation (Product Stewardship Program)."
 - (b) deleting the definition "Recycling Depot" and replacing it with the following:
 - ""Recycling Depot" means a facility for the receiving, collection, sorting and temporary storage of Recyclable Materials whose operation is the responsibility of the City or its designate as part of its recycling a program, or a Provincially authorized location for Mandatory Recyclable Materials."
- 2. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Bylaw No. 9904, being Amendment No. 4 to the Solid Waste Management Regulation Bylaw No. 9570.
- 3. Section 1 of Amending Bylaw No. 9904 comes into effect on July 1, 2008.
- 4. Section 2 comes into effect upon adoption of Bylaw No. 9904.
