Dear Mayor Shepherd:

On October 9, 2007 the Kelowna Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors unanimously passed a motion supporting the formation of an independent society called Tourism Kelowna. In reaching this decision, a number of key criteria needed to be met including a satisfactory staff transition plan, lease agreement, division of assets, governance structure, and formal approval given by the City of Kelowna

A Transition Team was established to work toward meeting these criteria. On November 27th the Transition Team presented its findings to the Kelowna Chamber Board of Directors, at which point the Board unanimously agreed to the formation of the Tourism Kelowna society.

Tourism funding currently flows through the Kelowna Chamber of Commerce as per previous agreements with the City of Kelowna.
