CHAIRMAN WILL CALL THE HEARING TO ORDER:

1.
 - (a) The purpose of this Hearing is to consider certain bylaws which, if adopted, shall amend *Kelowna 2020* - Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 7600 and Zoning Bylaw No. 8000.
 - (b) All persons who believe that their interest in property is affected by the proposed bylaws shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard or to present written submissions respecting matters contained in the bylaws that are the subject of this hearing.
 - (c) All information, correspondence, petitions or reports that have been received concerning the subject bylaws have been made available to the public. The correspondence and petitions received after February 1, 2008 (date of notification) are available for inspection during the course of this hearing and are located on the information table in the foyer of the Council Chamber.
 - (d) Council debate on the proposed bylaws is scheduled to take place during the Regular Council meeting after the conclusion of this Hearing. It should be noted, however, that for some items a final decision may not be able to be reached tonight.
 - (e) It must be emphasized that Council will not receive any representation from the applicant or members of the public after conclusion of this Public Hearing.

3. INDIVIDUAL BYLAW SUBMISSIONS:

3.1

BYLAW NO. 9923 (Z07-0098) **LOCATION: 1859, 1879 & 1891 Marshall Street, 508 Sutherland Avenue and off of Rowcliffe Avenue**

Legal Description: Lots 7 & 9, DL 14, ODYD, Plan 3286
Lots 1 & 2, DL 139, ODYD, Plan 3957
Lot B, DL 14, ODYD, Plan 18223

Owner/Applicant: Dale Riddell, David Bach, Nicole & Jason Marzinzik and Thieu Vu / (Jason Marzinzik)

Requested Zoning Change: From RM5 – Medium Density Multiple Housing zone to RU6 – Two Dwelling Housing zone

Purpose: The applicant is proposing to rezone the subject properties in order to reflect the single/two-family nature of the surrounding area and, as a result, help maintain the heritage characteristics of the neighbourhood.

BYLAW NO. 9926 (Z07-0037) **LOCATION: 1519 Feedham Avenue**

Legal Description: Lot 17, Sec 13, Twp 26, ODYD, Plan KAP75908

Owner/Applicant: Michael Zwicker

Requested Zoning Change: From RU1 – Large Lot Housing zone to RU1s – Large Lot Housing with Secondary Suite zone

Purpose: The applicant is proposing to rezone the subject property in order to legalize an existing secondary suite within the building.

BYLAW NO. 9927 (Z07-0094) **LOCATION: 530 Hardie Road**

Legal Description: Lot 14, Sec 26, Twp 26, ODYD, Plan 22499

Owner/Applicant: Mark Mudry / (Jerry Troitter & R446 Enterprises Ltd.)

Requested Zoning Change: From RU1 – Large Lot Housing zone to RU1s – Large Lot Housing with Secondary Suite zone

Purpose: The applicant is proposing to rezone the subject property in order to construct a secondary suite within the existing building.

4. PROCEDURE ON EACH BYLAW SUBMISSION:

- (a) Brief description of the application by City Staff (Planning).
- (b) The Chairman will request that the City Clerk indicate all information, correspondence, petitions or reports received for the record.
- (c) The applicant is requested to make representation to Council regarding the project and is encouraged to limit their presentation to 15 minutes.
- (d) The Chairman will call for representation from the public in attendance.
 - (i) The microphone at the podium has been provided for any person(s) wishing to make representation to the meeting.
 - (ii) The Chair will recognize ONLY speakers at podium.
 - (iii) Speakers are encouraged to limit their remarks to 5 minutes. However, if they have additional information they may address Council again after all other members of the public have been heard a first time.
- (e) Once the public has had an opportunity to comment, the applicant is given an opportunity to respond to any questions raised. The applicant is requested to keep the response to a total of 10 minutes maximum.
- (f) **Questions of staff by members of Council must be asked before the Public Hearing is closed and not during debate of the bylaw at the Regular Meeting, unless for clarification.**
- (g) Final calls for representation (Ask three times). Unless Council directs that the public hearing on the bylaw in question be adjourned (held open), the chairman shall state to the gallery that the public hearing on that bylaw is closed.

Note: Any applicant or member of the public may use visual aids (eg. photographs, sketches, slideshows, etc.) to assist in their presentation or questions. The computer station and ELMO document camera at the public podium are available. Please ask staff for assistance prior to your item if required.

5. TERMINATION
