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**RECOMMENDATION:**

THAT Council approve awarding the tender for Micro-Surfacing 2008 to the low bidder, McAsphalt Western Ltd., for the amount of \$ 728,937.07 (SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN Dollars and Seven Cents) including GST; AND

THAT the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to execute the Contract on behalf of the City.

**BACKGROUND:**

On February 26, 2008, bids were received in response to Tender T08-012 Micro-Surfacing 2008. Streets to be Micro-Surfaced in 2008 are primarily located in the Black Mountain area. The following bids were received, GST included:

McAsphalt Western Ltd.	\$ 728,937.07
West-Can Seal Coating Inc.	\$ 771,667.86

The bids have been reviewed for accuracy and errors. McAsphalt Western Ltd. has complied with the tender documents, and included the specified Bid Bond and Surety Consent for Performance and Labour and Material Payment bonds.

Upon award, construction of this project is anticipated to begin in early May 2008 with completion by May 31, 2008.

**FINANCIAL/BUDGETARY CONSIDERATIONS:**

This project will be funded as part of the \$3,475,000 Budget that was approved in the 2008 Provisional Budget for Road Resurfacing.



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
