Staff:

- Provided Council with a new Schedule 7 as the previous Schedule contained the "provisional" budget information, which has now been updated to contain the "final" budget impacts.

Council:

- Expressed a concern regarding the escalating infrastructure deterioration and the cost to replace it.

- Advised that the 10 Year Capital Plan and the 10 Year Servicing Plan will be brought forward to Council very shortly for review. Staff will also be providing Council with comments regarding Bill 27.
- Confirmed that all pertinent information will be brought forward to Council regarding the cost to replace infrastructure deterioration.
- Reviewed the Final Budget Submissions.
- Ensured Council that if any further budgetary funds are required, staff will come back with an amendment to the Final Budget as all of the Bylaws have been produced based on the Final Budget data currently before Council.

- Reminded Council that the Downtown Plan was initiated by the Downtown Centre Strategy Task Force as a planning guide for developing the downtown area. It was not meant to be a full review of the Downtown Plan and the Official Community Plan needs to be reviewed prior to a Downtown Plan being finalized.
- Advised Council that the appropriate time to make any decision with respect to the CD zone (agree to it or defer it pending receipt of additional information) would be when the Report to Council is brought forward for consideration.
