BYLAW NO. 9988

Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication Bylaw **(A Portion of Boyce Crescent)**

A bylaw pursuant to Section 40 of the Community Charter to authorize the City to permanently close and remove the highway dedication of a portion of highway on Boyce Crescent

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

1. That portion of highway attached as Schedule "A" comprising that portion of Boyce Crescent shown in bold black as Parcel A, Parcel B, Parcel C, Parcel D, Parcel E & Parcel F as Closed Road on the Reference Plan prepared by H.G. van Gurp B.C.L.S. and completed on 4th day of January, 2007, is hereby stopped up and closed to traffic and the highway dedication removed.
2. The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kelowna are hereby authorized to execute such conveyances, titles, survey plans, forms and other documents on behalf of the said City as may be necessary for the purposes aforesaid and to affix the Corporate Seal of the said City thereto.
3. City of Kelowna Road Closure and Removal of Highway Dedication, Boyce Crescent Road Bylaw No. 9678 is hereby repealed.
