BYLAW NO. 10000

Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2008

WHEREAS, there is an unappropriated balance in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund of Five Million, Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty-Five Dollars (\$5,335,745.00) as at January 1st, 2008.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for the purpose of land purchases and enhancements set out below;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sum of Five Million, Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty-Five Dollars (\$5,335,745.00) is hereby appropriated from the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund to be expended in 2008 for the following purposes:

General Land Acquisition Parks Housing Opportunity \$ 519,150.00 \$3,758,302.00 \$ 1,058,293.00

\$5,335,745.00

- 2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of Council.
- Should any of the above remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the City-Owned Land Reserve Fund.
- 4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2008, No. 10000".
