BYLAW NO. 10000

Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2008

WHEREAS, there is an unappropriated balance in the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund of Five Million, Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty-Five Dollars (\$5,335,745.00) as at January 1st, 2008.

AND WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable to expend a portion of the monies set aside under said Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund for the purpose of land purchases and enhancements set out below;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The sum of Five Million, Three Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand, Seven Hundred and Forty-Five Dollars (\$5,335,745.00) is hereby appropriated from the Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund to be expended in 2008 for the following purposes:

General Land Acquisition	\$ 519,150.00
Parks	\$3,758,302.00
Housing Opportunity	\$ 1,058,293.00
	<u>\$5,335,745.00</u>

2. The expenditure to be carried out by the monies hereby appropriated shall be more particularly specified and authorized by resolution of Council.
3. Should any of the above remain unexpended after the expenditures hereby authorized have been made, the unexpended balance shall be returned to the credit of the City-Owned Land Reserve Fund.
4. This bylaw may be cited as the "Sale of City-Owned Land Reserve Fund Expenditure Bylaw, 2008, No. 10000".
