Public Hearing May 27, 2008

A Public Hearing of the Municipal Council of the City of Kelowna was held in the Council Chamber, 1435 Water Street, Kelowna, B.C., on Tuesday, May 27th, 2008.

Council members in attendance: Mayor Sharon Shepherd, Councillors Andre Blanleil, Colin Day, Brian Given, Robert Hobson and Norm Letnick.

Council members absent: Councillors Barrie Clark, Carol Gran and Michele Rule.

- 1. Mayor Shepherd called the Hearing to order at 6:00 p.m.
- 2. Mayor Shepherd advised that the purpose of the Hearing is to consider certain bylaws which, if adopted, will amend "Kelowna 2020 Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 7600" and "Zoning Bylaw No. 8000", and all submissions received, either in writing or verbally, will be taken into consideration when the proposed bylaws are presented for reading at the Regular Council Meeting which follows this Public Hearing.

The City Clerk advised the Notice of this Public Hearing was advertised by being posted on the Notice Board at City Hall on May 9th, 2008, and by being placed in the Kelowna Daily Courier issues of May 20th, 2008 and May 21st, 2008, and in the Kelowna Capital News issue of May 18th, 2008, and by sending out or otherwise delivering 423 letters to the owners and occupiers of surrounding properties between May 9th, 2008 and May 14th, 2008.

The correspondence and/or petitions received in response to advertising for the applications on tonight's agenda were arranged and circulated to Council in accordance with Council Policy 309.

3. <u>INDIVIDUAL BYLAW SUBMISSIONS</u>

3.1 Bylaw No. 9989 (Z08-0020) – Christine Nicholls (Carla Boyczuk) – 886 Stonybrook Road – THAT Rezoning Application No. Z08-0020 to amend the City of Kelowna Zoning Bylaw No. 8000 by changing the zoning classification of Lot A, District Lot 579 Similkameen Division Yale District Plan KAP84472, located at 886 Stonybrook, Kelowna, B.C. from the RU1 – Large Lot Housing Zone to RU1s – Large Lot Housing with Secondary Suite Zone be considered by Council.

3.2 <u>Bylaw No. 9994 (Z08-0017) – Robert Schleppe – 2242 Stillingfleet Road</u> – THAT Rezoning Application No. Z08-0017 to amend City of Kelowna Bylaw No. 8000 by changing the zoning classification of Lot 5, DL 136, ODYD, Plan 10841, located on Stillingfleet Road, Kelowna, B.C. from the RU1 – Large Lot Housing zone to the RU6 – Two Dwelling Housing zone.

(Hangingstone Properties/Robert Bennett) – 3665 McCulloch Road - THAT Rezoning Application No. Z08-0012 to amend the City of Kelowna Zoning Bylaw No. 8000 by changing the zoning classification of a part of Lot 85, Sec. 3, Twp 26, ODYD, Plan 1247, located on McCulloch Road, Kelowna, B.C., from the A1 – Agriculture 1 zone to the RR3 – Rural Residential 3 zone, as shown on Map "A" attached to the report of Planning & Development Services Department, dated April 8, 2008, be considered by Council.
